### TEXTS: ROMANS 1:1-7

#### THE RECAP: (10 MINUTES)

In week 1 of the Romans series Pastor Joby explains that the Apostle Paul wrote the letter to the Romans while he was in Corinth on his third missionary journey. The purpose of Romans is to share the Gospel; we were dead in our sin and enemies of God, but God came to rescue us in Jesus. Faith is not just knowing this, but to surrender to Jesus as Lord. Obedience is the true measure of a person's faith.


## **TEACHING & DIALOGUE**

#### Have someone read Romans 1:1-7 out loud.

- What does this Scripture tell us about Jesus? (Jesus fulfilled all the Old Testament prophecies of a Savior. Jesus' life, death, resurrection, ascension, and return is God's plan of redemption.)
- Why is the Gospel never something we graduate from? (The Gospel is the only way to God. It is not something we just believe in our heads but the Gospel brings us from death to life and transforms us.)
- 3. Why is Jesus' resurrection such a big deal? (It confirms Jesus is really who He says He is- God.)
- 4. Why does obedience to God matter? (To surrender is to commit. Obedience is for our own good and with the purpose to draw us closer to God.)
- 5. Where in the Old Testament do we see a foreshadowing of the coming Christ? (Some examples are: In Exodus- the Passover Lamb, In Ruth- the Kinsman Redeemer, In Isaiah- the suffering prophet)
- 6. Why is it important to identify these passages in the Old Testament? (The whole Bible, cover to cover points to Jesus. The point is Jesus!)
- 7. What does this mean for you? (God's love is so great and so deep that He knew you would need to be rescued and He did not stay passive.)
