

PROPHETS PRIESTS KINGS - WEEK 2: ONE MORE GENERATION

THE POINT: PARENTS: OF ALL THE PEOPLE IN THE ENTIRE WORLD, GOD HAS CHOSEN YOU TO HAVE THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY OF RAISING YOUR CHILDREN. BE REMINDED THAT HE IS NOT CALLING US TO MERELY RAISE GOOD CITIZENS, BUT TO RAISE JESUS FOLLOWERS.

TEXTS: 1 SAMUEL 1:21-28

TEACHING & DIALOGUE


Have someone read 1 Samuel 1:21-28 out loud.

In due time, Hannah was given a child. She promised the Lord that if she was given a son, he would be given to the Lord. She planned to trust God with her son. The time is now here where she will trust the Lord with her son.

1. **Take a few moments to think about the sermon. What is one thing you learned about who God is by hearing the sermon?**
2. **How do verses 21-24 show Hannah and her husband putting God at the center of their actions and conversation with each other?** *(Hannah's husband leads his family well by taking them to worship God. He also responds to Hannah by reminding her to follow in the Lord's will, which she then does by taking her son to the Lord's house after weaning him.)*
3. **Hannah asks God for something and God answers. She worships and prays before and after God answers her request. God hears prayer based not on us, but on his son and his perfect payment for our sin. What do you need to worship and pray about now, and to worship and pray about later when God answers?** *(Remember, God always answers prayer with a yes, a no or a wait. Worshipping God and praying to Him are for our good and His glory.)*
4. **Hannah trusts God and lends her son to the Lord. We are on a two-year journey of trusting God called the ONE initiative. Where is God calling you to trust Him?** *(This could be anywhere. God could call you to trust Him more with your talent, with your time, with your treasure or with anything else.)*
5. **In the ONE initiative, we place a special focus on ONE MORE generation. How does Hannah's example of prioritizing raising her child faithfully impact you?** *(It could challenge you, it could encourage you, it could remind you to do something).*

Have someone reread 1 Samuel 1:27-28 out loud.

Parents, you are the primary disciple maker in your household. God has chosen YOU to have the primary responsibility of raising your children. Hannah trusted God's plan for her child and gave him to the Lord.



We all have an opportunity to go deeper through Family; family that is fueled by life together. The old saying is "it takes a village to raise a child". As disciples of Jesus, we know we don't want the villages of this world to raise our child(ren); we want the church, because we want to raise disciples!

6. **What does surrendering your children to the Lord look like for you?** *(For those with kids, it might mean working less to spend quality time with the family. It could mean working more to be the provider God has called you to be. For those without kids, it means praying for all of the ONE MORE generation you know and discipling them.)*
7. Look at page nine in your first Samuel journal. Parents, just like Hannah, you are the primary example of obedience to Christ for them to follow. Choose one of these ten ways to connect with your kids this week. Which one will you put into practice?
