Malachi - WEEK 3: Drifted

The Point: If you have drifted, REPENT and make Jesus the ONE THING THAT DRIVES EVERYTHING.

SERMON TEXTS: Malachi 2:1-9, Revelation 2:1-5, Acts 19:17-29

Discussion Questions

(The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. It is ok if you don't cover every question).

DISCOVER

Have someone read Malachi 2:1-3 out loud.

1. In these verses, God tells us how He feels about being dishonored. What are some of the ways that we dishonor God? (When we ignore God or His Word, when we treat worship casually or when we treat sin as if it's "no big deal").

Now, have someone read Malachi 2:4-6 out loud.

2. God reminds His people of their original priest Levi, who "stood in awe of My name." What are some of the ways Christians can show honor to God? How can you personally show honor to God this week? (Primarily, we honor God when we believe the gospel of Jesus Christ and take His Word seriously. We get to "stand in awe" of God through seeing blessings all around us. Truly, it's only by having Jesus give us a new life that we can ever really honor God).

Have someone read Malachi 2:7-9 out loud.

3. The role of the Old Testament priest is similar to that of modern day church leaders. In v. 7, they are called to "guard knowledge." This is referring to Biblical knowledge. Why does Biblical knowledge need to be guarded? What has a tendency to happen? (Like a precious deposit that we have been entrusted with, the truth of the gospel needs to be guarded. We have to be careful because what often happens over time is that people water down the gospel or try to make it "less offensive" to the world around us. The truth of the gospel is "offensive" in the sense that it tells us that we are hopeless without Jesus to rescue us).

DEEPEN Have someone read Revelation 2:1-5 and Acts 19:17-20 **4.** What does it mean when a church or a Christian for that matter, drifts? How serious is it? (Pastor Joby talked about the church at Ephesus that had "lost their first love." In Revelation, the Lord challenged them to "do the things they did before." Drifting is very serious and that is why God, as a loving Father, warns us about it).

5. Of the 11 things that Pastor Joby mentioned, what are one or two that you feel the Spirit is telling YOU to consider and what step towards them will you take this week? (Answers will vary. Spirit filled evangelism, life transformation, quit faking it, breaking down the dividing wall, be in awe of God, worship, confession, repentance, sacrificial giving, diving into the Word and serving).

ACTION STEP

There are over 7,000 promises of God in His Word. Spend some intentional time this week choosing some of them to meditate over. Ask the Holy Spirit to use this exercise to stir your heart in worship. Find a quiet place to reflect on and enjoy these promises, allowing yourself to worship in response.
