Malachi - WEEK 4: Marriage

The Point: Our marriages are not primarily about us, but a reflection of God's covenant love for His people.

SERMON TEXTS: Malachi 2:10-16

Discussion Questions (The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. It is ok if you don't cover every question).

DISCOVER

[PLAY VIDEO]

Have someone read Malachi 2:10-12 out loud.

1. What do these verses reveal about the nature of God? Why is it important to know who and what God is? (He is our Heavenly Father, He is jealous, holy and worthy and will not share His glory with another).

2. God is saying to His people that they are rejecting Him by marrying people who don't believe in Him. How is this the case? What harm is there by doing it? (Unequally yoked. God knows that to keep His people pure and holy, they need to only marry those who profess His name. By inter-marrying with those who do not believe and follow the one true God, the Jewish people will be polluted with false religion).

3. What can we learn that is so important for our own faith from verse 12? (He means what He says and says what He means. There are severe consequences from breaking His commands. Obedience is better than sacrifice).

DEEPEN [PLAY VIDEO] Have someone read Malachi 2:13-16 out loud.

4. How is our obedience to God connected to His response regarding our prayer requests? (God takes our willful rebellion to His commands seriously. We cannot expect answers to our prayer requests when we are knowingly sinning).

5. We say our marriage is a covenant, but we often treat each other like a contract. What are you doing that is an example of treating your spouse like you are in a contract? (Answers will vary).

6. As a man, what could you do that would reflect knowledge of studying your wife and becoming an expert of who she is as a woman? As a woman, what could you do as his helper so that he feels like you are on his team and that he has what it takes? (Answers will vary).

ACTION STEP

Take time to ask your spouse one or two ways you can better show your convenantal love for them. Write it down on a note and place in your Bible as a bookmark so that every time you are in the Word, you are reminded of your covenant before God to your spouse.
