The Point: Gospel amnesia will allow us to waste our lives in a wasting world.

SERMON TEXTS: 2 Peter 3:1-18

Discussion Questions

(The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. It is ok if you don't cover every question).

DISCOVER

Have the group take turns and read all of 2 Peter 3:1-9.

- 1. Peter feels a responsibility toward the recipients of this letter. What is his hope and goal in writing to them? (Peter is wanting to prepare/equip them for what they are going to be facing. He wants them to understand God's character so that it will give them the benefit of right thinking for right choices).
- 2. Why would it be important to know that "scoffers" are expected in the last days? How might that affect believers? (It could cause them to doubt God's Word or character, that the gospel isn't true and relevant, that there is no real consequence to rebellion, to lose our focus in life).
- 3. In what ways do you feel that scoffing is on the rise in our day? What challenge does that pose for you? (Answers will vary but can include the political correctness over justification of immorality, the degrading of traditional values and Christian faith, the freedom to choose for ourselves what is "right without fear of consequences." Basically, the way the world identifies wrong as right and right as wrong and how that makes it hard to live contrary without the push-back/ridicule from our cancel culture).

DEEPEN

Have someone read 2 Peter 3:10-18 out loud.

- 4. In v. 10-11, Peter explains about the "day of the Lord" and how that is supposed to impact how we live. Do you live with a kingdom mindset? Do the end times matter to you and if so, in what way? (Answers will vary).
- 5. In verses 12-14, Peter mentions looking FORWARD to this day. Why would believers eagerly anticipate God's kingdom? It will mean judgment for unbelievers but what does it mean for believers? (It will mean that our reward is finally coming to fruition, when we get to be with Jesus and enjoy a new heaven and a new earth, where righteousness dwells. It also means that this moment should motivate us to remember why we are here in the meantime God doesn't need our good works but our neighbors do).

ACTION STEP

Group – Right thinking impacts our ability for making a right response. What is the next step for you after listening to this sermon? What right response needs to be taken this week and how will you do that?
