## These 3 Remain- WEEK 3: Love

THE POINT: We love because he first loved us. – 1 John 4:19

SERMON TEXTS: 1 Corinthians 13, 1 John 4:7-21

### Discussion Questions

(The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. It is ok if you don't cover every question).

## DISCOVER

Have someone read 1 Corinthians 13:1-7 out loud.

1. How does God define love and how does this help us understand the importance He has for it in His kingdom? *(Love is premium, the utmost highest calling in life and faith. It is to be the foundation with which we determine each step. God values love more than anything else. It is selfless and sacrificial).*

2. How are verses 4-7 a description of who Jesus is? *(Try re-reading those verses, replacing the word "love", with "Jesus." He is the living embodiment of the concept of love, our practical example of what it looks like to love others well).*

Have someone read 1 Corinthians 13:8-13 out loud.

3. Considering what will remain even in heaven, why is love considered greater than faith and hope? *(In heaven, faith becomes sight and hope becomes our experience. We will see Jesus in all His glory and our hopes will be realized. Love will last eternally because God is love and therefore will be in heaven).*

## DEEPEN

Have someone read 1 John 4:7-21 out loud.

4. Judging from these verses, describe the way God demonstrates His love for us and how that should impact our love toward others? *(God loved us first. He initiates with us for our good. He looks out for us and it costs Him to love us. Therefore, we should take the initiative with others for the sake of love, be willing to pay a price for loving others well. Love is action).*

5. Do you show love through your actions? What's hard about loving others like God loves you? *(Answers will vary).*

6. How does God's love for Himself and His love for us, empower us to love ourselves and others? *(It is impossible to love God and hate others. It is a lie to say that we love God but hate our brothers or sisters. Because God is love and we have the Holy Spirit in us, the more we know God and grow closer to Him, the more the Holy Spirit uses that to enable us to love like He does).*

## ACTION STEP

Consider how your view of God shapes your view of you and everyone. How is God wanting you to love in such a way that it reflects His nature more than your own? What is one way you can implement that this week? Share with your group how you can commit to this and be prepared to give an update next week.
