The Point: The Church of Eleven22 is a movement for all people to discover and deepen a RELATIONSHIP with JESUS CHRIST.

SERMON TEXTS: John 5:18-47

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

*Leader – read the prayer from page 53 of your Gospel According to John journal.

1. **What came to mind as this prayer was being read?** *(Answers may vary.)*

Have someone read John 5:18-47

2. **What is Jesus teaching us about the importance of the relationship between the Son and the Father?** *(God the Father loves God the Son, Jesus, and shows him everything he's doing. What Jesus sees the Father doing, He does likewise. Jesus can do in the physical what the Father does in the spiritual.)*

3. **What kind of relationship do you feel like you have with Jesus? What about with God the Father?** *(Answers may vary. Leaders – lean into answers where there is a significant difference in the way someone relates to Son vs. the Father. Ask those having similar relationships with the Son and Father to explain more.)*

4. **Jesus can either be our Savior or our judge. What does it mean for Jesus to have authority to judge (verse 27) and does it impact the way you view your relationship with Him?** *(Jesus has full authority to execute judgement or save into eternal life. We can put ourselves in a dangerous position when we try to sit on the fence or stay neutral about Jesus' authority. Jesus is full of love and came to save all who hear his words and believe. Jesus' words proclaim He has the authority to judge. Right understanding of Jesus leads us to a right response to worship Him for ALL that he is.)*

DEEPEN

Have someone read Acts 2:42-47.

Leader Read Out Loud: *At the beginning of each disciple group trimester, we read from Acts 2 to be reminded of what the first disciple groups looked like and see how we can live out biblical community together.*

5. What stands out to you in these verses? *(Answers may vary. Leaders – ask good follow up questions to dig deeper into your groups first answer or response, to get to the root of why that particular thing stood out.)*

6. How can we as a disciple group live out what is modeled for us here in Acts? *(Answers may vary, but options could include: gathering every week to read the bible and discuss God’s word along with the weekly sermon; attending services together, especially big events like Saturated and Beach Baptism; having time set aside for a fellowship focus, which we call Group Connect Events, to just have fun and get to know others in a more relational way.)*

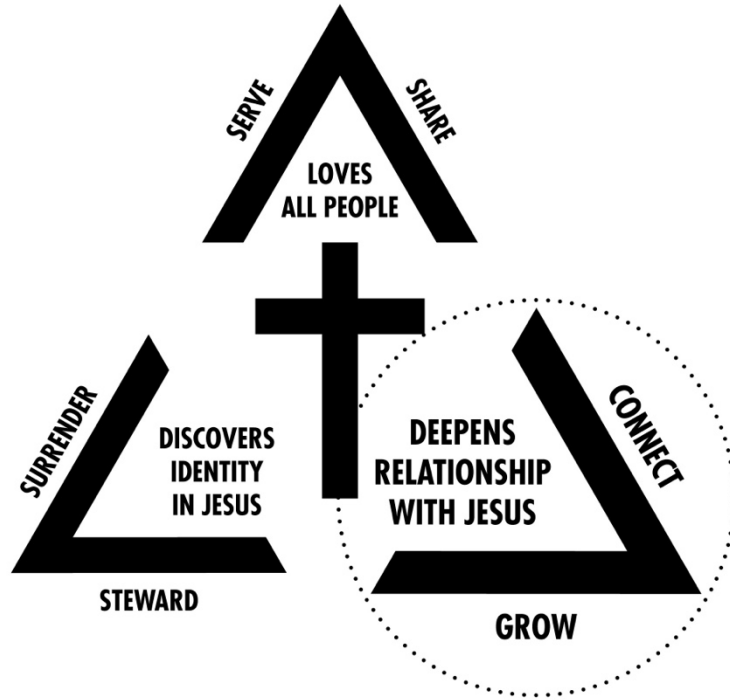
ACTION STEPS

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

One way to deepen our relationship with Jesus is through connecting with faith family. One of the ways to connect to the faith family is through a disciple group. Disciple groups operate best when they have *Relational Rhythms* built into each trimester.

- 1. Everyone take a look at the *Relational Rhythms* calendar and think through how you could help facilitate or coordinate one of the following:** Connect Nights, Sent Events, or Deepen Nights.
- 2. Come to group next week with the date you would like to coordinate an event.**
