The Point: You will find what you are looking for. If you are looking for reasons to not believe, there are many: social, theological, historical, religious, traditional...but if you are looking for true life, you will find it in Jesus alone.

SERMON TEXTS: John 7:1-52

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

Have someone read John 7:1-9

- 1. We live in a world full of noise, distractions and over the top commentary on everything. How do you discern what is true and what is false? (A boldly spoken lie is still a lie, while a softly spoken truth is still the truth. We can confuse confidence for truth, and meekness as a lack of confidence.)
- 2. Jesus knew the Father's will was for him to go to the cross, but it wasn't yet time. What is the difference between God's will and God's timing? (We can know what God wants us to do and yet we may have to wait on His will to play out. Trusting God is never late means we have to wait at times.)

Have someone read John 7:10-18

- 3. What is Jesus teaching us in these verses? (Our beliefs and doctrines should not be based on anything other than God's word. Our education, birth order, family, economic status, etc. cannot be the defining factor of our belief system. Jesus is our defining factor.)
- 4. What do you think about when you think about God? Are your thoughts based on experiencing Jesus, or what you hear others say about Jesus? (Answers may vary. A.W. Tozer said, "The most important thing about you is what you think about when you think about God.")

DEEPEN

Have someone read John 7:37-44.


- 5. You will find what you are looking for. What are you looking for in the world right now and why? (Answers may vary.)
- 6. Do you thirst for a deeper relationship with God? How can you stir your affections for Him? (Answers may vary.)

ACTION STEPS

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

As disciples seeking to deepen our relationship with Jesus, we get to connect with other believers and grow in our faith. This week consider your answers from the deepen section (questions 5 & 6):

- 1. Prioritize time this week to focus on the truth that Jesus alone will quench your deepest thirst.
- 2. Prayerfully consider the following:
 - What do you want, why do you want it, and is there sin at the root of this want?
 - What have you wanted in the past, didn't get, and now see as a blessing?
