The Gospel According to John - Good Shepherd

The Point: All this world can offer is heartbreak, self-indulgence and disappointment. A full life can only be experienced in the fullness of Jesus Christ.

SERMON TEXTS: John 10

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

Have someone read John 10:1-9

1. Do you have a friend or family member whose voice you could recognize no matter what is going on around you? Why is it easy to pick out their voice? (Answers may vary.)

2. Do recognize Jesus' voice in the midst of the noise all around you? What noise(s) is trying to block out Jesus' voice in your life right now? (If you're struggling with hearing Jesus' voice, the easiest place to hear from Him is through reading the Bible. After reading a few verses, stop and meditate on what Jesus is saying and what that means for you.)

3. How does Jesus want us to enter into the sheepfold? Why does he promise the ability to go in and out to find pasture? (John 10:1 says we are to enter through the door, "...he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber." Jesus is the door.)

Have someone read John 10:10-18

4. What is Jesus describing in these verses? (Jesus is describing the differences in pursuing what this world defines as abundance, a better life, and His abundant life, pursuing the One who is better than life it-self.)

5. What else stood out from these verses, either as we read them, or from Pastor Adam's sermon? (Answers may vary. Jesus' fourth "I Am" statement and third saying "I Am God." Jesus didn't come to make us good but to give us abundant life; the fullness of life only Christ may provide. We also see truths about Satan: he's real, a liar, powerful, brilliant, hateful and has a mission to destroy us and our relationship with Jesus.)

DEEPEN

Have someone read John 10:25-30

6. How are you loving God with all of your heart, soul, mind and strength? Where would you like to take a step in your relationship with Him? (Believers are called to love God will ALL. He is not just to be the top of our list, but the paper or the filter in which we construct our list.)

ACTION STEPS


A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

As disciples of Jesus, we show our love for him by surrendering to His Lordship and fighting against all this world tries to offer through the truth of who Jesus says he is.

This week spend time meditating on Jesus' "I Am" statements, letting each one saturate your heart, soul, mind and strength:

- ...the bread of life. John 6:35
- ...the light of the world. John 8:12
- ...the door. John 10:9
- ...the good shepherd. John 10:11
- ...the resurrection and the life. John 11:25
- ...the way, and the truth, and the life. John 14:6
- ...the true vine. John 15:1
