# The Gospel According to John – The Way

**The Point:** "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me." – Jesus (John 14:6)

SERMON TEXTS: John 14:1--30

# **Discussion Questions**

## **DISCOVER**

Have someone read John 14:1-14

- 1. Imagine you have been invited to the greatest party the world has ever known, but you're not sure where to go. What would you do and why? (Some may choose to look for clues in the invitation. Others may search the internet for answers. You might try asking around to see if others are going to the party. The only way to guarantee you find what you are looking for is go to the One who invited you. Jesus's life, death and resurrection is the invitation to the party...eternal life.)
- 2. In John 14:6, Jesus says, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life..." What does each one of Jesus's statements about who He is mean? (Jesus is everything God wants the world to know in a person! Jesus is the Word of God, which means Jesus is the truth, see John 1:1-5. Jesus is the only way. All other human inventions to attain a right standing before God should be rejected as fruitless endeavors. Jesus is the creator and sustainer of life, see Colossians 1:15-20. Jesus offers both eternity in Heaven and a life focused on the eternal while we are still here on earth.)
- 3. Reread verses 13,14. What does it mean to ask for something in Jesus's name? What doesn't it mean? What are you asking for right now? (Our prayers and requests should reflect who Jesus is and his character. Asking for something in Jesus's name means we are focused on what would glorify Jesus the most. Praying in Jesus's name should hopefully give you courage to pray boldly and patiently.)

Have someone read John 14:15-38

4. What promises does Jesus offer in theses verses? How might these verses help you fight against a troubled heart? (Knowing and loving Jesus gives us His Helper, the Spirit of God that lives inside every believer. The Spirit helps teach us knew things every time we open the Bible, the Spirit helps us pray, and helps us to be comforted in times of distress.)

## **DEEPEN**

Eleven22 is focusing on the word **Relationship** from our vision statement during this year. Disciple groups are one way to deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ through growing in our faith and connecting with the faith family.

Have someone read Acts 2:42-47

5. How do you prioritize prayer and time in the Word? How would you like to grow in both this fall? (Answers may vary.)

6. Let's brainstorm ways we can live out these verses from Acts 2. How can we help each other be more like Jesus? And how can we create a safe place to be vulnerable and honest with what is really going on in our lives? (Answers may vary.)


# <u>ACTION STEPS</u>
