The Gospel According to John – Whom Do You Seek?

The Point: The only way to seek Jesus is through surrender.

SERMON TEXTS: John 18:11-4; Luke 22:39-46; Matthew 26:20-46; Luke 15:28-32

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

Leader Read: Over the next three weeks we will all share parts of our testimony (life before knowing Christ as Lord, how we meet Jesus and became saved, and what life looks like now as a believer).

1. This week let's start out by remembering, and sharing, what our lives were like before Christ. What were you seeking and where were you seeking it? (Answers may vary. Leaders: Similar to a personal testimony, encourage EVERYONE in your group to share this part of their story.)

Have someone read John 18:1-14

- 2. How do these verses contrast the different participants in Jesus' arrest? (Pastor Joby used an illustration of four chairs to explain the different participants in the arrest of Jesus. 1. Soldiers who revere Jesus but are against Him 2. Judas, close in proximity and activity, but betrayed Jesus with his life 3. Peter, who truly believes, and still made mistakes along the way 4. Jesus, who is surrendered to the Father's will, not His own. Jesus is God in human flesh and the other participants are humans, sinners by nature.)
- 3. What does it mean to "cut off an ear" in Jesus' name? Have you ever responded like Peter? (Answers may vary Leaders: Dig deeper and challenge your group to repent, ask for forgiveness, make a phone call or whatever may be needed for Jesus to redeem that relationship.)

Have someone read Luke 15:28-32

4. Consider what Jesus is teaching us through these verses. Is there an example of sin to avoid? How about an example for us to follow and model ourselves after? (Answers may vary.)

DEEPEN

Eleven22 is focusing on the word **Relationship** from our vision statement during this year. Disciple groups offer one way to live out what it means to be a disciple through discovering an identity in Jesus as Lord, surrendering our entire lives to Him.

Have someone read Matthew 26:20-25


- 5. All the disciples call Jesus, "Lord," except Judas, who calls Him, "Rabbi." What is significant about the different titles? What is Jesus teaching you and what do you need to surrender? (Answers may vary. If Jesus is NOT Lord of all, He is not Lord at all!)
- 6. How has The Gospel According to John series impacted you the most and who have you shared that with outside of Eleven22? (Answers may vary Examples: I learned something new about God or about myself, surrendered a sin that was trying to kill me, or found deeper community with believers.)

ACTION STEPS

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

Leader: We are having #onemore weekends the next three weeks to close out TGAJ. We are going to pray for your #onemores right now. <u>ASK</u>: Everyone to share the name of at least one person they want to come to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Take a Next Step: This week, extend an invitation to your #onemore: invite to church, invite to coffee, invite to our disciple group, invite to go on a walk, etc. Come ready to share who you invited, what you invited them to do, and how it went.
