# The Gospel According to John - Extravagant Gratitude

The Point: The heart of worship is gratitude for who Jesus is and what He has done for us.

SERMON TEXTS: John 11:45 – 12:11

# **Discussion Questions**

# **DISCOVER**

Have someone read John 11:45-57

- 1. Why are the Pharisees' hearts considered hard in these verses? When do you find yourself having a hardened heart and what's the danger that comes from it? (The Pharisees are so concerned with themselves and their motivations it's impossible for them to marvel. We too can miss Jesus when our hearts are focused on others' blessings, and don't have an attitude of gratitude for what God has done for us.)
- 2. What is lordship? How is Jesus' lordship impacting your life? (Lordship is simply allowing Jesus to tell us what to do, what to think and how to behave. Believers must surrender everything to Jesus, trusting He is better, and He will now define our lives.)

Have someone read John 12:1-11

- 3. What are the three different responses to Jesus attending the party? What is your natural way to respond to Jesus? (All three responses are appropriate because they are overflows of gratitude. Martha responds by serving, Lazarus responds through abiding and Mary responds through sitting at the feet of Jesus. We get to respond through singing and raising our hands.)
- 4. What holds you back from extravagant gratitude? Where do you see yourself as more consumer than worshipper? (Answers may vary.)

# **DEEPEN**

Have someone read Psalm 50:23; Hebrews 13:15-16

- 5. What promises does God offer us in these verses? (God says we will glorify him when we surrender things over to Him. When we sacrifice things for God, out of thankfulness for Him, we are glorifying Him. It's all out of a response to who Jesus is by acknowledging his name.)
- 6. What do you need to surrender to God right now? (Answers may vary.)


# **ACTION STEPS**

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

The heart of worship is gratitude for who Jesus is and what He has done for us.

# This week when you pray, start by telling God how great He is. Use the following:

- Adoration Tell God all of the things you adore about Him; worship, praise and honor of God.
- <u>C</u>onfession Tell God all of the sin in your life.
- Thanksgiving Tell God what you are thankful for in your life.
- Supplication Pray for the needs of others and yourself.
