Discussion Questions

Spring Trimester Group Kick-off Questions

- 1. Pastor Joby said Eleven22's focus for 2021 will be on relationships through three big objectives: Loving God by loving our #onemore; Loving God by loving one another; Eleven22 Life. Which objective are you personally most looking forward to and why? (Find an electronic copy of the vision piece at coe22.com/vision)
- 2. What are some ways that our disciple group can love God by loving both #onemore and one another this trimester? (Use this time to hear from your group on how they hope to grow closer with each other and create opportunities to serve locally, serve at a campus, invite their #onemores to a service or group and deepen their relationship with God and others.)

DISCOVER

Ask someone from your group to read Hebrews 12:1-9 out loud.

- 3. Why is the writer of Hebrews reminding us to never forget who we are and who God is? (Hebrews 12:5,6 is quoting Proverbs 3:11,12. To exhort means to strongly encourage or urge someone to do something. The writ-er wants us to be reminded that we are sons and daughters of the cross. This also reminds us of our identity, and the rela-tionship that comes with that identity.)
- 4. The word discipline is used six times in these nine verses. How do you naturally respond to that word, and why? (Answers may vary Leader ask follow up questions: Tell me more. What else? Verses 10-13 and question 4 we will get to contrast people's experience with earthly discipline and the Lord's.)

DEEPEN

Ask someone from your group to read Hebrews 12:10-13 out loud.

- 5. What do these verses tell us about the Lord's discipline? Where have you experienced the Lord's discipline in your life? (God disciplines for our good, to share His holiness, and it yields peaceful fruit.)
- 6. What does God promise will come to believers, from his discipline? (From His loving discipline we may be healed. Therefore we can lift up our hands in praise, we will be strengthened and our paths will be made straight.)

ACTION STEP

*Leaders – These next eleven weeks we will be focusing on the "For Reflection" questions in the Song of Solomon Journal. Please stay connected with your group throughout the week, gently reminding them to spend quiet time with the Lord reflecting on the questions.

Group – Reflect and Pray: Find a quiet place this week and reread Hebrews 12:1-13, and then ask God to show you the following: 1. What weight or sin am I carrying around and need to let go of (12:1)? 2. Where are you disciplining me right now (12:5-6)? 3. What is my next step (12:12-13)?
