Preach! - Hating Your Sin Through Joy

The Point: When you stare at this gospel, share it, and the things of earth will grow strangely dim, in the light of his glory and grace. So, fix your eyes on him, who fixed his eyes on you. Then you will have self-control over all things.

SERMON TEXTS: 1 Corinthians 9:23-27; 1 Corinthians 10:11-13; Hebrews 12:1-3

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

Have someone read 1 Corinthians 9:23-27

- 1. Where do you find joy? How do you express joy? (Answers may vary. Leaders: Encourage the group to not overthink the questions. Just say the first thing that pops into their head.)
- 2. How can someone simultaneously live-in freedom, while giving up their freedom? (We get to live in the freedom that somehow Jesus' death on the cross counted for us. Possibly more amazing is that somehow His perfection is given to us. Read 2 Corinthians 5:21. Believers give up their freedom to do what we want, when we want by also submitting to God's authority and being obedient to his commands.)
- 3. What is biblical self-control? How is joy both a source and result of self-control? (Pastor Kwon taught us this week that self-control is not about will power, but joy-power. In joy-power we recognize the desires we have and reallocate that emotion/desire to a greater prize.)
- 4. Eternity with God is the ultimate imperishable prize, but can a believer accumulate other imperishable prizes on this side of eternity? (Our material goods are perishable, but that doesn't mean we cannot take anything with us to heaven. Matthew 6:19-20 says, "...but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven..." This is living the Eternal Life while here on earth! Examples: sharing the gospel with your friends/family, being kind, serving those in need, forgiving people, and killing the sin that's killing you.)

DEEPEN

Eleven22 is focusing on the word **Relationship** from our vision statement during this year. Disciple groups offer one way to live out what it means to be a disciple through discovering an identity in Jesus as Lord, surrendering our entire lives to Him.

Have someone read 1 Corinthians 10:11--13 and Hebrews 12:1--3

- 5. What is something you desperately want to stop, but just can't? (Answers may vary.)
- 6. How can you find joy through Loving All People, Discovering and Deepening your relationship with Jesus Christ? (Answers may vary this could be surrender, stewardship, sharing the gospel, serving others, connecting or growing. See Discipleship Journey Tool for more specific questions to ask yourself.)


ACTION STEPS

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.
