The Point: Every great gift demands a great response.

SERMON TEXT: John 3:16

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

Have someone read John 3:16

1. What can be known about both God and man, through this single verse? (<u>God</u> is love and His love is set forth to men in Christ Jesus. God's love is infinite and inexhaustible. God is triune. God offers everlasting life to ALL people through belief. <u>Man</u> needs saving and we cannot save ourselves. Man is in a finite state because of sin, which leads to perishing, which is eternal separation from God.)

2. What did you learn about the word "perish" or "perishing" from Pastor Albert's sermon? Where are you perishing? (Perishing does not start after physical death. The sinful nature in which we were born means we can be in a state of perishing on this side of death. Living outside of God's presence and outside of His plan and purpose for us leads to our perishing in the present.)

Have someone read Psalm 23

3. What do these verses tell us about God and the promises he offers us? (The Lord is a good shepherd. He provides everything we need, from rest and peace, to renewed strength. God promises to be with us through good and bad times; He's greater than our circumstances. God pursues us forever!)

DEEPEN

Eleven22 is focusing on the word **Relationship** from our vision statement during this year. Our relationship with God begins with being created in His likeness, a likeness that grows.

Have someone read Ephesians 4:17-24

4. How have you grown in your Christlikeness in the past year? (Answers may vary.)

5. Where are their opportunities for you to grow in your Christlikeness? (Answers may vary.)

<u>ACTION STEPS</u>

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

Leader: Pastor Albert Tate shared how his daughter has grown to look more and more like him as she has grown up. Likewise, the longer we are followers of Jesus we should see ourselves growing more like Him and putting off our old self.


Take a Next Step: This week we will deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ by growing in our knowledge of God. If we are created in His likeness, then we must know what that means. God has many attributes. Some of these attributes are specific to God and not shared with us (*incommunicable*). But there are other attributes of God that He has chosen to share with us as His created image bearers (*communicable*).

- Pick one shared (communicable) attribute of God from the list below and learn as much as you can about it (what is the attribute, what does it mean, where do we find it in scripture, how is it used, etc.)
- Come prepared to share what you learned next week
