SERMON TEXT: Hebrews 11:11

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

Have someone read Hebrews 11:1--11

1. **Last week the action step was to pick an attribute of God and learn more about it. What attribute did you pick, what did you learn and how does that part of God's character give you a more hopeful faith?** *(Answers may vary – all of God's attributes, or character/nature is the root of who God is. Growing in that knowledge of God leads believers to deepening their relationship with Him.)*
2. **Do you fully believe the universe was created by God speaking? How does your belief about creation shape the way you view v1?** *(Answers may vary.)*
3. **Why does the writer of Hebrews want us to remember examples of faith from the book of Genesis to support v1?** *(God is faithful and has been faithful since the beginning!)*
4. **Name one unanswered prayer that you have stopped bringing to God. Do you feel convicted to start praying that prayer again, why or why not?** *(Answers may vary.)*

DEEPEN

*Eleven22 is focusing on the word **Relationship** from our vision statement during this year. Our relationship with God begins with being created in His likeness. As we grow in our faith, more and more of God's likeness is revealed in us and seen by others.*

Have someone read Genesis 18:11--14 and 2 Corinthians 5:7

5. **How can you relate to Sarah in these verses?** *(Answers may vary – the important thing to recognize is Sarah was caught up in her circumstances.)*
6. **Where is the Lord calling you to walk by faith right now? What's holding you back?** *(Could be in sharing.)*



This Week: *As a group we will pray together in three different ways*

1. Celebrate Wins – Everyone take a turn saying a quick thank you to God for one thing you are thankful for
2. Partner Up – Spend a few minutes praying specifically for one thing that your partner is hoping for
3. Intercessory – As a group pray out loud together for a single person in the group (you can pray for each person individually or for 1-2 people that request specific prayers for healing, deliverance, etc.)
