SERMON TEXTS: Acts 2:42-47

Discussion Questions

(The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. It is ok if you don't cover every question.)

DISCOVER

Have someone read Acts 2:42-47 out loud.

- 1. Pastor Joby mentioned that in order to understand the church we must first understand God's character. What does God want us to know about His character based upon these verses?** *(We can look back to the beginning of Genesis to see how we have been created out of God's love for God's self. The perfect relationship of our triune God was poured out into creation, and we have been created in that same image, an image of being created to live in relationship.)*
- 2. What do you see from Acts 2 that stirs your heart for Biblical community?** *(Answers may vary)*
- 3. How can we, as a group, live out Acts 2 in this "year of relationship" in our church?** *(Answers may vary. Opportunities exist for us to read and study of God's word daily, to regular times of eating together, serving together, and praying for one another. Groups can look for times to invite their #onemore's to group.)*

DEEPEN

Take turns reading John 13 out loud as a group.

- 4. What does Jesus teach us about relationships from this passage?** *(Answers may vary.)*
- 5. Reread John 13:34-35. How are you loving others like Christ loved you?** *(Answers may vary.)*

ACTION STEP

Group – This week, pray through each of the three objectives in the vision piece. Pray for the objective itself, pray for God's Spirit to empower His people, and pray for those that God will draw unto Himself.
