The Point: We bring to God our first and best because God first loved us by giving us His best in Jesus Christ.

SERMON TEXT: Genesis 4:1-7; Genesis 1:1; John 1:1-4; Colossians 1:15-18; Deuteronomy 6:4-5; Romans 5:8; John 3:16; 1 John 4:10; Matthew 6:19-21, 24, 33; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER (If you use the video curriculum, play the first part before you discuss the discover questions.)

LEADERS – Remember: you don't have to cover every question. Let the Holy Spirit be your guide. Every week we're asking you to start the discussion with these two questions. It's a great way to get the conversation started.

- What stood out to you from the sermon and how can you apply that this week?
- What did God reveal to you in any of the scriptures this week, maybe for the first time?

DEEPEN (If you use the video curriculum, play the second part before you discuss the deepen questions.)

LEADERS – For the duration of this sermon series we will be using the questions in the 10:10 Life Journal. Encourage your group members to bring their journals to service each week, think about the questions while they're listening to the sermon and then write out their answers before they attend group. It will lead to some great discussions.

NEW: Our film team has created a different 10:10 Life video for each week of the sermon series. It's a fiveminute video at the beginning of the video curriculum. (You will find it on the same page you find the <u>written</u> <u>curriculum</u>.) We recommend you download it before you show it to your group to make sure you don't have any Internet issues.

Read Genesis 4:1-7

- What was the difference between Cain's offering and Abel's offering? What was God's response to their offerings? What does this tell us about the importance of how God views our response to who He is?
- How have you forgotten that everything you have ultimately belongs to God? What first and best is God calling you to bring back to Him?
- How have you lived with a "leftover mentality" (giving God your leftovers)? What is the root of this mentality? Fear, idolatry, pride?

ACTION STEP

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

Take what God has shown you through your time in His Word and, reflecting on the previous questions, apply it to your life this week.

- 1. Turn to page 22 and read about the Eternal Life initiative. Take a few minutes to think about how you are using everything God has given you. Are these God-given things being used to build the kingdom of God or chase after things that will never satisfy? What needs to change for you to have a more eternal perspective?
- 2. Write out a prayer asking God to bring your one more to surrender to Him.
