# DISCOVER

**LEADERS – Remember: you don't have to cover every question. Let the Holy Spirit be your guide.** Every week we're asking you to start the discussion with these two questions. It's a great way to get the conversation started.

- What stood out to you from the sermon and how can you apply that this week?
- What did God reveal to you in any of the scriptures this week, maybe for the first time?

### DEEPEN

**LEADERS** – For the next five weeks we will be using the questions in the 10:10 Life Journal. Encourage your group members to bring their journals to service each week, think about the questions while they're listening to the sermon and then write out their answers before they attend group. It will lead to some great discussions.

Read Matthew John 10:1-21

- Go back through the Scriptures and list out all the things Jesus said He does as the Good Shepherd. How does the truth that Jesus is my Good Shepherd change the way I think about Him and obey Him?
- What does it mean to live an abundant life in Christ? Am I currently living that abundant life? If not, what is holding me back from it?
- What lies am I believing that tell me temporary things will satisfy my soul? What do I need to do to combat these lies?


#### A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.
