**The Point:** Religion kills. It's a trick. It convinces people that they are saved by their good works and self-righteousness.

**SERMON TEXT:** 1 John 2:15-17; Ezekiel 28:17; Isaiah 14:12-15; Proverbs 16:18; Genesis 3:5; James 4:16; James 4:6; Psalm 10:4; Romans 2:8; and Proverbs 16:18; Col 3:12; James 4:10; 1 Cor 1:31, 4:7; James 5:16

## **Discussion Questions**

**DISCOVER** (If you use the video curriculum, play the first part before you discuss the discover questions.)

**LEADERS** – Every week we're asking you to begin with these two questions. It's a great way to get the conversation started.

- What stood out to you from the sermon this week?
- What did God reveal to you in any of the scriptures this week, maybe for the first time?

**DEEPEN** (If you use the video curriculum, play the second part before you discuss the deepen questions.)

Read 1 John 2:15-17

- Everyone's life is "defined" by something. What do you say defines your life? What would your close friends say defines your life? (How you define your life gives you a certain understanding, life purpose and definition of success. Do you define your life by your job, title, income, marital status, children, sexuality or possessions? If you primarily define your life by the world's systems, values and standards, it's loveless and all you will ever have are desires, unmet cravings, lusts and an appetite for more. Jesus commands us, "Do not love the world or the things in the world...")
- What is the "pride of life" and why is it something God hates and directly opposes? (Pastor Flynt said, "Pride is a soul issue that leads you to project false or inflated versions of yourself in order to gain a sense of value or worth, which is what you really believe it takes to be accepted." According to scripture, pride is the root of all sin and makes us like Satan. Pride is evil. Pride kills your relationships, your joy, and ultimately, you. Pride will keep you from seeking Jesus and lead you to rejecting God. Scriptures on this include Ezekiel 28:17; Isaiah 14:12-15; Proverbs 16:18; Genesis 3:5; James 4:16; James 4:6; Psalm 10:4; Romans 2:8; and Proverbs 16:18.)
- How does God help you reject defining your life by "the world and the things in this world"? (This is the invitation: reject defining your life by "the world and the things in this world" and define your life by the love of God in Jesus. In John 6:28-29, the disciples asked Jesus: "What must we do, to be doing the works of God?" Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent." Doing the will of God is code for believing in the love of God in Jesus the Gospel! It's defining your life by the good news of God's love and not by the world. 1 John 2:17 says, "...whoever (all) does the will of God abides forever (abundant, eternal life)." How good is God that he would give you things to help you reject pride: Humility (Col 3:12; James 4:10), Gratitude (1 Cor 1:31, 4:7), Confession (James 5:16), Prayer and Worship.)

#### A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.


Write down how you currently define your life the way the world does. On the other side of the paper write down one or two ways you can redefine your life by the love of God in Jesus.
