Psalms Week 12: Create In Me a Clean Heart

The Point: "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." Psalm 51:10

SERMON TEXT: Psalm 51; 2 Samuel 11-12, Proverbs 5-7

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

LEADERS: Ask someone to read 2 Samuel 11 and use the questions as a guide for discussion.

- What are the steps that David took on the path that led to sin? (In 2 Samuel 11, we see David heading down a path. David abdicated his responsibility to lead the army in war and became idle. He stopped looking and started lusting after Bathsheba who was not his spouse. He didn't flee from lust and created the environment for him to sin sexually. Then, David murdered Bathsheba's husband, Uriah, to cover his sexual sin.)
- When in your life can you look back and see that you were on a path to destruction? (Pastor Joby reminds us that it's direction, not intention, that determines destination. All of us are on a path leading somewhere! It's often easy to see the final steps leading to sin, but difficult to recognize the first steps on that path. All types of sin are symptoms of the root cause which is to reject God, say we are our own God, and our will and way is better than His. But God's word says that He always gives us a way out of temptation.)

Read 2 Samuel 12:1-13 and use the questions as a guide for discussion.

- What would you say to someone who asked you why God takes sin so seriously? (God is Holy and cannot live with sin. Sin separates us from God. Romans 3:23-25a assures us that, "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith." Pastor Joby pointed out that in the account of David and Bathsheba the words sex, murder and lying were not used. Those are all symptoms of the problem: sin. The only cure is the blood of Jesus.)
- How is it possible that God's mercy is not a violation of His justice? How do both God's justice &
 mercy exist together? (God is both the just and the justifier. God's justice means sin must be paid for,
 in His mercy Jesus pays for our sin. It's the kindness of God that leads us to repentance; it is God's
 judgment to turn us over to our desires. Repentance is recognizing that It's not enough to be sorry; I
 need to be different. It's not just renewed effort. God promises to save us from sin, but not from the
 consequences of our sin.)

DEEPEN

Let's go deeper into God's word and discuss how we can apply these truths to our lives!

LEADERS: Use the following questions as a guide to go deeper into our discussion.

- Meditate on Psalm 51:11. When have you felt your sin was going to separate you from God? What did you do about it? What does the Bible tell us about being separated from God?
- God's word is a mirror to our life. How can we approach our time reading the Bible in a way that truly seeks God to create in us a new heart? (Ask God for ears to hear, chains to fall off, forgiveness to be poured out, shame would be removed, freedom would abound and healing would reign.)
- If you were the enemy, how would you attack you?

<u>ACTION STEP</u>

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

Leader Read: King David had the prophet Nathan in his life to help him see his own sin. Do you have a Nathan in your life who can give you wise counsel on your struggles?


This Week: Find your Nathan. This could be someone in this disciple group, someone you serve alongside or just someone that you know who loves Jesus!

- "I will" pray for God to show me one person who would be a good Nathan to me.
- "I will" invite this person into my life for accountability and encouragement.
