Psalms - Week 17: Give Thanks

Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

The Point: "Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name!" (Psalm 100:4) We all live on a continuum between gratitude and entitlement. Do not let this world drag you away from thanksgiving and into despair.

SERMON TEXT: Psalm 100, James 2:14, Matthew 25:31-46, John 5:37-40, John 13:1-16

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

LEADERS: Ask someone to read Psalm 100.

- What stood out to you from the sermon? How can you apply that this week?
- What did God reveal to you in Psalm 100 this week, maybe for the first time?

DEEPEN

- What does the meaning behind "steadfast love" (hesed in Hebrew) tell you about God, his character and his attributes? (Pastor Joby painted a picture of a nursing mother's response to the cry of her baby; there's a physiological need to nurture and what comes out of her is exactly what the baby needs. Every time we cry out in worship, God responds with exactly what we need in that moment, reflecting his provision, compassion, wisdom, and love. God demonstrates that He is trustworthy we can trust Him to respond every time.)
- How does Jesus change the way we enter God's presence? (In the Old Testament, only the high priest, one day a year, could enter the Holy of Holies and experience the presence of God. A thick veil separated God from the people. When Jesus said on the cross, "It is finished," the veil was torn in two from the top to the bottom. We can now be "priests unto our God" and, as his children, we can come into His presence at any time and ask questions with boldness and accessibility.)

LEADERS have someone read James 2:14 and Matthew 25:31-46.

• Why does serving with gladness matter? (Psalm 100:2) (First, God commands us to serve with gladness and joy. Secondly, serving with a bad attitude misses the point of worshiping God and loving others. Serving with gladness is good for our hearts and a blessing. Though a believer may not always feel like serving or begin serving with gladness, by God's grace, they can always finish with gladness.)

ACTION STEP

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.


Choose one of these action steps to do this week.
