WHAT'S HAPPENING IN YOUR LIFE: (Learn about, encourage and pray for one another.)

- How were you obedient to God this past week?
- Where did you struggle this past week?

If the Tomb is Empty – Mount of Temptation – With What Weapon Will You Fight The Enemy?

The Point: Our enemy, the devil, is the Father of Lies. Do not believe the whispers but, stand on the truth of the word of God. "It is written..."

SERMON TEXT: Matthew 4:1-11, Romans 12:1-2, Ephesians 6:10-17, Genesis 3:1-6

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER

Read Matthew 4:1-11 and James 1:14-15. Use the following questions as a guide for discussion.

- Jesus was tempted by three things in the desert: the lust of the flesh (hunger for bread), the lust of the eyes (desire for power), and the pride of life (using power for selfish gain). How does the enemy still use those same lies in your life today? (The enemy has three lies that he comes at us with: Lust of the flesh: a desire to FEEL a certain way. Lust of the eyes: a desire to HAVE something you don't have. Pride of Life temptation to BE somebody or something.)
- Satan wants you to question the Word of God, the work of God, or the worth of God. What seeds of doubt do you currently have and what lies are they rooted in? (Answers may vary. 2 Corinthians 2:11 don't be outwitted by the schemes of the devil.)
- Why is it that believers who have surrendered to Jesus still experience temptation? (The Bible says that Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. Though God has given us a new heart, the process of sanctification while we're on earth wages war against the lies of the enemy, the world, and of our own flesh.)

DEEPEN

In light of what we have discovered through God's word and discussed above, let's go deeper and discuss how we can apply these truths to our lives!

LEADERS: Read Romans 12:1-2 and then use the questions below as a guide for discussion

- In what ways is the world trying to mold you, and what does it mean to NOT be conformed to that? (Be specific and use I statements.)
- How do we renew our minds, and why does that lead to transformation? (Pastor Joby shared that
 our only offensive weapon in spiritual warfare is the Word of God per Ephesians 6. Time in God's
 word is how we renew our minds as believers. Renewing something requires removing the old first

before adding the new. Progressive sanctification is God both identifying what to shave down to nothing and what to build up in us.)

*Leaders: Spend time working through the action step together this week!

ACTION STEP

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

This Week: We must confront the lies that we believe and replace them with God's truth. God's truth is the only truth; therefore, we must be transformed by the renewing of our minds. To do this we will do two things:


- Consider the following lies (or others) and how they are affecting your life
