If the Tomb is Empty – Mount Calvary – What Is Finished?

**The Point:** When Jesus was on the cross and said, "it is finished," it counted for you.

SERMON TEXT: Psalm 22; Luke 23:34; John 19:26-28, 30; Luke 23:43,46; Mark 15:34

# **Discussion Questions**

#### **DISCOVER**

LEADERS: Take turns reading Psalm 22 as a group. Use the questions as a guide for discussion.

- What parallels do we see between Psalm 22 and the gospel accounts of Jesus's crucifixion? How does the comparison impact your understanding of Jesus's experience on the cross? (Pastor Joby shared that Christ quotes the beginning of Psalm 22, using a "remez," on the cross and that those words are Christ's final opportunity to share the Gospel with those watching. Pastor Joby explained that a remez is part of a Scripture passage that would allow the Jewish people to determine for themselves the fuller meaning of the teaching.)
- Pastor Joby discussed the seven statements that Jesus made from the cross. Which of these phrases stood out to you and why? (Answers will vary.)
- TETELESTA!! When Jesus said, "It is finished," that counted for you. What is the importance of the word tetelestai? What is finished? What does that mean for you? (The sacrificial system, your sin, guilt, condemnation, religion, being good enough, trying to earn God's favor, addiction, slavery to sin and law, loneliness, hopelessness, to name a few...Jesus paid the substitutionary atonement. God made Him who was without sin to be sin for us so that we would be made His righteousness. 2 Cor 5:21).
- How is Jesus's statement in Luke 23:34 clear through His entire life and ministry? (Jesus repeatedly told the disciples that He was here to take away the sins of the world. He knew they couldn't understand, but He kept explaining, using miracles and parables to reach the people.)

#### **DEEPEN**

Let's go deeper into God's word and discuss how we can apply these truths to our lives!

**LEADERS:** Read Luke 24:1-12 and then choose 1 or 2 questions below as a guide for discussion.

- Jesus's resurrection is proof that He isn't finished. How is Jesus working in your life? Is Jesus alive and reigning or is He still lying in that tomb?
- What does the empty tomb mean to you

- What has God revealed to you during the season of Lent? How has the Holy Spirit changed you or your circumstances?
- Are you fully surrendered to the lordship of Jesus Christ? Are there places in your heart where you are holding back, places where Jesus is not Lord?

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.


**This Week:** As you consider that we are nearing the end of the Lent season, reflect on where you are called to be a peacemaker and not just a peacekeeper.
