Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

The Point: Following Jesus is so much more than right and wrong; it is life or death.

SERMON TEXT: *James 1:12-18; 2 Timothy 4:8; 1 Corinthians 9:25-27; 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20; 1 Peter 5:4; Romans 5:6-8, 6:23; Revelation 2:10, 4:10-11*

Discussion Questions

LEADERS: There's no pressure to get through all the questions, we suggest prayerfully planning your choices for your group. Your leadership of sharing and questioning will determine how deep your group goes with each question.

- **What stood out to you in the sermon this week?**
- **Read *James 1:12-18*. What did God reveal to you in the scriptures this week, maybe for the first time?**
- **Faith in Jesus produces faithfulness to Jesus.**
Discover: Share a time you've seen this in your life or the life of someone you're close to.
Deepen: What is the greatest hinderance to faithfulness in your life?
- **Pastor Britt preached, "Temptation increases as responsibility decreases."**
Discover: Explain that and share how you have experienced it in your life.
Deepen: "Let no one say when he is tempted, 'I am being tempted by God,' for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one." (James 1:13) How does this truth help you when you face temptation? How do you "remain steadfast under trial"?
- **Our culture defines sin in many ways, and often quite differently than God does.**
Discover: **What is sin?** (*Sin is our rebellion against God. Sin is a state of being. It is powerful force coded into our DNA. It is alive, it is aggressive, it is deceptive, and it is impossible to cure in and of our own efforts. It is a deep rejection of God's ultimate good and God's glorious rule. Sin is the non-supremacy of God who was made manifest in the person of Jesus Christ.*)
Deepen: **James 1:15 says, "...sin when it is fully grown brings forth death."** **Where in your life do you need to take your sin more seriously?** (*It can be hard to be totally honest about your sin. Do you need to invite a close friend in your group to breakfast so you can talk with them about the sin you're struggling with? See the action step this week for help with confessing your sin to God.*)

ACTION STEP

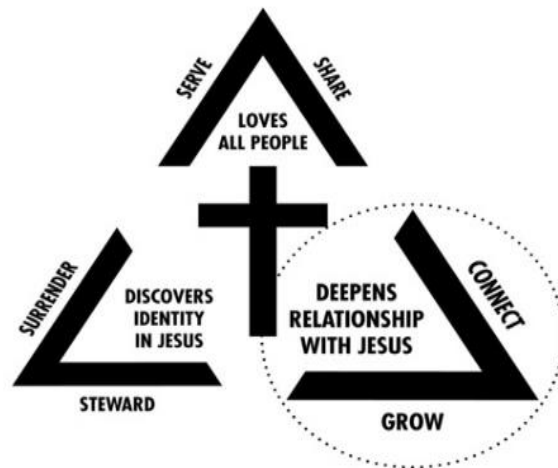
A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

Confessing is simply telling the truth. When you tell God the truth about your sin you are acknowledging that you need Him and that you trust Him. Confess sin in your life by writing it down and going to the altar this week to pray.

If you are new to confession, pray this simple prayer: Lord, I confess my _____. This sin is trying to kill me, and I need Your help. Please forgive me of my sin against You. Help me to believe what You have said about Yourself and about me. Give me the strength to turn away from my sin and trust You. Amen.
