Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

The Point: The theological reality of the gospel is that Jesus's life, death and resurrection has reconciled you to the Father. The relational reality of the gospel is that the gospel should connect you to the body of Christ. If you are in Christ, you should be a part of His family, the church.

SERMON TEXT: Philippians 1:3-11; John 15:1-11; Galatians 6:14

Discussion Questions

DISCOVER (If you use the video curriculum, play the first part before you discuss the discover questions.)

LEADERS – Every week we're asking you to begin with these two questions. It's a great way to get the conversation started.

Action Step check-in: As a church, we are memorizing scripture during this sermon series. Have someone recite the verse from last week, *Philippians 1:2.*

- What stood out to you from the sermon this week?
- What did God reveal to you in any of the scriptures this week, maybe for the first time?

DEEPEN (If you use the video curriculum, play the second part before you discuss the deepen questions.)

Read Philippians 1:3-11

• Philippians 1:3-4 says, "I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy," Who is praying for YOU? Who are you praying for?

GROUP ACTION: (If you don't have someone intentionally praying for you, ask someone in your group, right now, to be that person or think of who that person could be. Take five minutes right now, to write down the prayers you want prayed and give those requests to your prayer partner.)

- Philippians 1:5 continues, "because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now." Pastor Joby outlined four things that are necessary to be in "partnership in the gospel." Which one are you most inconsistent with or struggle with? 1. Receive the gospel: Have you surrendered? Have you believed the good news? 2. Be a Part of the body: You can't be a lone partner. Get connected and take a next step of faith. 3.Partner in preaching the gospel: Where are you sharing your story of faith? 4. Partner in generosity to push the gospel forward.
- God created us to be in relationships with Him and other people. Describe what a real, Godly
 friendship looks like. Who is, or could be, that type of friend in your life and what can you do to
 cultivate that relationship? Who are you thankful for when you think of them?

ACTION STEP

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

As a church, we are memorizing Scripture over the next nine weeks. Memorizing Scripture renews and guards our mind, strengthens our faith and prepares us for spiritual battle. We memorize God's Word to fix the verse in our minds so that the Holy Spirit will recall it whenever needed.


- 1. This week memorize *Philippians 1:6*, "And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ."
