The Point: The only paperwork that matters on the day of judgment is not your resume, but Christ's invitation.

SERMON TEXT: Philippians 3:1-11; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Romans 3:20-26; Romans 9 and 10

Discussion Questions

LEADERS – Your leadership of sharing and questioning will determine how deep your group goes with their answers. Every week we're asking you to begin with these two questions. It's a great way to get the conversation started.

Action Step check-in: Have someone recite the memory verse from last week.

- What stood out to you from the sermon this week?
- What did God reveal to you in any of the scriptures this week, maybe for the first time?

Read Philippians 3:1-11

- In Philippian 3:2, Paul calls out the "enemies of the Gospel" who believed more than Christ was required for salvation. Pastor Joby pointed out there are two parts of the Gospel (recall Pastor Joby's banking example). Discover: Discuss them. Deepen: Are there times you don't believe the WHOLE Gospel? Share when and why. (Your salvation is not about you. It's through Jesus, PERIOD. Jesus plus anything, ruins everything. You must repent of your wretchedness, résumé, religiosity and self-righteousness. The essence of sin is man substituting himself for God. The essence of salvation is God, through Jesus, substituting himself for man. The half Gospel is Christ's sacrifice washes away your sins. The whole gospel is, in addition to that, Jesus's righteousness is credited to you. Salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone.)
- Philippians 3:3 says, "For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh." Pastor Joby said church folk like us can start to put confidence in our own actions our "Christian scorecard," résumé, religious activities and good works. Discover: What is on your Christian scorecard that leads to confidence in the flesh? Deepen: In Philippians 3:9 Paul says, "and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith." How does this righteousness, that comes through faith, differ from the righteousness we may try to earn? (Your actions can be worship or offensive depending on your motivation. We can do good works because we are overwhelmed by the grace of Jesus and we want to follow and obey him, or we can do good works that God sees as filthy rags because we're trying to earn our way to God's grace. Grace isn't anti-effort, but it is anti-earning.)
- Philippians 3:7-8 says, "But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord..." Imagine knowing Jesus like that. It can be difficult to explain how we know that we know Jesus without describing religious activity. Try to describe how you know Him, personally. (One way to explain it is it's the difference between internal experience and external evidence. When you have experienced the fruit of the Spirit internally the love, joy, and peace of Jesus you know Him. Only then can that experience overflow into external activity that glorifies Him.)

ACTION STEP

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus.

As a church, we are memorizing Scripture during this series.


